1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No. 3 and 4 to make the payment of due admitted amounts to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate time bound directions are issued to respondent No. 3 (Managing Director, Punjab State Grains Procurement Corporation, Anaj Bhawan, Sector 39-C, Chandigarh) to decide legal notice dated 19.04.2025 (Annexure P-5), served by the petitioners.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for petitioners, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Managing Director, Punjab State Grains Procurement Corporation, Anaj Bhawan, Sector 39-C, Chandigarh (respondent No. 3 herein) to decide legal notice dated 19.04.2025 (Annexure P-5), served by the petitioners expeditiously, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
