Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.822 dated 10.11.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar.

2. The petitioner, who was named in the FIR, was later on, declared as innocent by the police and was not challaned by the police but summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the learned trial Court.

3. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join proceedings before the trial Court.

4. Today, counsel for the petitioner made statement that by virtue of the earlier order, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court and he also produced copy of the relevant order whereby the presence

of the petitioner is marked in the Court concerned on the basis of the aforesaid order of interim bail.

5. Reply filed on behalf of the State by way of affidavit of Kamaljeet Singh, DSP, HQ, Hisar is ordered to be taken on record along with Annexure R-1.

6. State counsel, on instructions from SI Anil Kumar has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court on the basis of previous order of interim bail.

7. In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.11.2024 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
