MAIN CASE

Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to adjust the petitioner in the DCCW Dadri or preferably in the DCCW Bhiwani on the basis of adjustment letter dated 21.12.2020 considering the seniority of the petitioner against the post of Account Clerk or any post commensurate with her qualification.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 files his memo of appearance on behalf of the said respondent and informs that the above said letter dated 21.12.2020 already stands withdrawn vide order dated 10.03.2021. Hence, the claim of the petitioner for adjustment on the basis of the said letter would not be

sustainable. He further undertakes to supply a copy of the abovesaid withdrawal order dated 10.03.2021 to counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day. He further submits that he has instructions to submit that the respondent-Department would have no objection to take a time bound decision on the fresh representation submitted by the petitioner on 25.10.2024.

Counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the same; but he contends that his right to challenge the order of withdrawal dated 10.03.2021 be kept open.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting on merits of the case and without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to take recourse to appropriate remedy(ies) in accordance with law against the order dated 10.03.2021 withdrawing the adjustment order dated 21.12.2020, if so advised, with a direction to the respondent No.3- Honorary General Secretary, Haryana State Council for Child Welfare, Bal Vikas Bhawan, Chandigarh to take a decision on the representation submitted by the petitioner on 25.10.2024 in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
