**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)**

This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 01.12.2021 passed by this Court in CWP-33150-2019.

Pursuant to previous order dated 01.02.2024, respondent No.1- Mr. Amit Kumar, Joint Development Commissioner, Rural Development Punjab is present in the Court and has filed short reply by way of his affidavit. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it appropriate place.

Respondent No.1 has submitted that the order dated 01.12.2021 was never brought to his notice. Therefore, the said order could not be complied with by him. Now, enquiry already stands completed, therefore, the said fact cannot be undone. However, respondent No.1 has expressed his apology in the Court for having proceeded further in the matter.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

Presence of respondent No.1 is exempted.
