1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.3 & 4 and to take action as per law against respondents No.5 to 7 in FIR No.305, dated 26.10.2024, registered under Section 3(1) (r) of SC & ST Act, 1989 and Section 351(2) of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Urban Estate, District Hisar (Annexure P-1) against the private respondents as respondent No.4 in connivance with private respondents is delaying the matter in illegal manner and also pressurizing the petitioner to withdraw and compromise in FIR against respondents No.5 to 7 and respondent No.4 is causing unnecessary delay in the proceedings.
2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the Investigating Agencies are intentionally not proceeding with the investigation.



3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4 On asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State. He, on instructions has submitted that after the investigation, cancellation report has already been recommended and the same would be filed before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks.

5. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the investigating agencies that cancellation report as submitted before this Court be presented before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned within two weeks from today. On doing so, the learned trial Court would issue notice to the petitioner-complainant and after hearing him, decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
