1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order bearing No.A/1(Madan Lal)/PF/3502 dated 08.01.2025 passed by respondent No.3 whereby the claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he has instructions to withdraw the instant writ petition to file a fresh petition after impugning the order of compulsory retirement of his father.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents contends that his objection against maintainability of the writ petition be kept open alongwith the objections as regards the merits to any such petition being instituted since the order of retirement had attained finality and the father of the petitioner died after passing of the order of retirement and its implementation.



4. While keeping all objections of the respondents open and observing that the withdrawal of the present writ petition should not be construed as an expression of granting permission to raise a challenge, the prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

5. Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file an appropriate petition, if so advised.
