Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0033 dated 27.04.2025 under Sections 118(1), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) of BNS added later on), registered at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, has apprised the court that in compliance of order dated 24.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further investigation.
