1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against respondents for non-compliance of order dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP-12858-2018.

2. The counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the order passed by this court in CWP-12858-2018 has since been stayed by the Division Bench of this court in LPA.

3. The counsel for the respondent-State has filed reply on behalf of respondents by way of affidavit of respondent and has corroborated the aforesaid fact that the Division Bench has stayed the matter.

4. In view of the above, this court does not find it appropriate to proceed further in the matter. Hence the present petition is dismissed.

5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file again if stay is vacated or LPA is decided in favour of the petitioners.
