1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0224 dated 25.11.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 333, 351, 191(3), 190 of the BNS, 2023 and Section 118(2) of BNS added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna/District Ludhiana Punjab.
2. Vide order dated 10.01.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Pal Singh, has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
