1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 05.12.2023 as modified by order dated 30.01.2024 passed by this court in CWP-22545-2014.

2. In compliance of order dated 21.03.2024, passed in the present petition, the counsel for respondents has placed on record a communication dated 02.07.2024 addressed to the petitioner, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for respondents has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by



paying the arrears of pension and commutation. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
