The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 3.8.2017, vide which direction was issued to pay subsistence allowance to the petitioner from the date of termination till passing of final order. Secondly, the final orders were directed to be passed within four weeks.

Reply by way of affidavit of Amit Talwar, PCS, Divisional Manager, Chandigarh Transport Undertaking-cum-Director Transport, UT, Chandigarh dated 17.1.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said reply, sanction of the subsistence allowance has since been received and bill has also been sent to the treasury. However, the amount has not been disbursed to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the amount be paid to the petitioner in the form of a demand draft on or before 5.2.2019. It is further stated that the final order dated 15.1.2019 has since been passed, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.

In view of above, no useful purpose would be served in continuing the present contempt petition. The same is accordingly disposed of with the aforesaid observations.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.

However, the amount shall be deposited within the time framed as above, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition. If the petitioner is forced to file application to revive the present case, heavy penalty shall be imposed.
