1. This Contempt Petition is filed by the petitioner against non-compliance of an order dated 17.03.2023 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab.

2. In the opinion of this Court, the contempt proceedings directly filed before this Court would not be maintainable under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. If the petitioner is aggrieved of the non-compliance of the orders passed by the *quasi* judicial authorities, he has to move appropriate application before the concerned Revenue Court alone for execution of its order. The concerned Court may, if it is found that there is a deliberate and willful non compliance, refer the matter to this Court in terms of Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 being Court of record. Direct contempt proceedings would not be maintainable.

3. Accordingly, this Contempt Petition stands **dismissed**.

4. All pending applications filed in this Contempt Petition shall stand disposed of.
