**AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)**

1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to count the part-time service of the petitioner rendered before her respective regularization, as a qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits, with regard to which reliance is placed on **Jeewan Lata vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP-10238-2017, decided on 10.05.2019 and **Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP-2371-2010, decided on 31.08.2010. Regarding the claim raised in the present case, a representation dated 08.01.2025, Annexure P-5, has been submitted, which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same keeping in view the abovesaid judgments, in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

2. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 08.01.2025, Annexure P-5, taking note of the afore-judgments, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to her and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
