AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.27013 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of the above discussion, the official respondents are directed to give appointment letter to the petitioner with all consequential benefits, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned State counsel has filed recommendation letter dated 15.07.2019 whereby petitioner has been selected and stand at

Sr. No.4-A in the joint merit list for the post of Industrial Extension Officer. He states that appointment letter will be issued expeditiously not later than three weeks from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives.

The present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
