1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P-1).

2. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with. Petitioner No.1 has been held to be ineligible, whereas, petitioners No.2 and 3 have already been promoted after their consideration.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

4. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
