1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to reframe the select list of EWS Category vis-à-vis the select list of General/Open Category for recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector.
2. This is third round of litigation. The petitioner initially filed *CWP No.16683 of 2024* which was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file afresh with better particulars. The petitioner preferred second *CWP No.17926 of 2024* which was disposed of without liberty.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of judgment dated 14.10.2024 (Annexure P-12) passed by Division Bench of this Court in *Sikander Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others*, *CWP No.4264 of 2021* and instruction dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-13)

issued by the respondent, fresh cause of action has arisen, thus, writ petition is maintainable.

4. On account of passing of an order by the Division Bench in different cause of action, this Court cannot permit the petitioner to file fresh writ petition when earlier was dismissed without liberty.
