Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for directing official respondents, especially respondent No.5- Chief Commissioner (Sales), Faridabad to decide the revision petition filed under Section 8 of the Haryana Evacuee Properties (Management and Disposal) Act, 2008, which is pending for 07.05.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.5 (Chief Commissioner (Sales), Faridabad) for deciding the aforesaid revision petition preferred by him, which is pending for 07.05.2025.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ram Kumar, Reader, Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad, submits that in all probabilities, the aforesaid revision petition shall be considered and decided
