The present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for quashing of FIR No.51 dated 27.03.2021, under Sections 1323, 325, 34 IPC (Sections 201, 148, 149 and 34 added later on), registered at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar, along with all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P-2/A).

This Court vide order dated 28.07.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties appeared before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, and got their statements recorded. On the basis of statements so recorded, learned

Magistrate has submitted his report dated 20.08.2025 and submitted that as per the statement of the parties, the compromise dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P-2/A) effected between them appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State Counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR No.51 dated 27.03.2021.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench Judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the present petition is *allowed* and FIR No.51 dated 27.03.2021, under Sections 1323, 325, 34 IPC (Sections 201, 148, 149 and 34 added later on), registered at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar, along with all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P-2/A) are quashed qua the petitioners.
