1. Present petition has been filed seeking protection of petitioners from the harassment being caused by respondents No.2 to 5 at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.2 to 5 to submit the status report as to why the petitioners No.1 and 2 are being harassed and being beaten up for no cause.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that brother of petitioner No.1 is married with one Chandani, (who is daughter of respondents No.6 & 7), regarding which respondents No.5 to 7 are threatening the petitioners and they have given them beatings also. It is submitted that the petitioners have filed a complaint/representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) for the redressal of their grievance, before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if complaint/representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) is decided in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. P.P., U.T. Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
5. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh is directed to decide the complaint/representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.
6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
