The marriage between the parties was solemnized according to Hindu rites and ceremonies at Jammu on 25.02.1994. On account of matrimonial disputes between the parties, the appellant filed petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 on 20.09.2007, seeking dissolution of marriage between the parties by a decree of divorce. His petition was dismissed by the learned Additional District Judge, Panipat vide impugned judgment and decree dated 22.05.2009. Aggrieved against the same, the appellant file the present appeal.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal, as efforts are afoot for amicably resolving the dispute.

The learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the same.
