**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider them for absorption in terms of judgment dated 06.03.2024 passed by this Court in "*HC Balbir Singh and Ors. Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.*" **CWP-19966-2017.**

2. Learned State counsel who on advance notice is present in Court submits that this Court vide afore-cited judgment dated 06.03.2024 has declared few clauses of the Standing Order invalid. The State has filed intra-court appeal against aforesaid judgment which is still pending before Division Bench of this Court. The State has not issued another Standing Order. The Rules itself are under challenge. In such

circumstances, final decision would be taken up after either adjudication of petitions/LPA by this Court or introduction of new standing order. Thus, instant petition at this stage is premature.
