The present petition has been filed for seeking directions to the respondents to maintain law and order and ensure that no untoward incident takes place in the petitioner-institution.

2. Apprehending undue harm and untoward situation during the admission year, the present petition has been filed on the ground that the respondents are likely to infringe the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as disturb the academic atmosphere in the petitioner institution.

3. A status report by way of affidavit of Rajinder Singh Manhas, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur has been filed. The relevant extract thereof reads as under:-

*“That it is humbly submitted that the matter has been enquired by SHO, Police Station Dinanagar. The statement of the petitioners as well as of the respondents No.5 & 6 were also recorded. During the inquiry the allegations levelled by the petitioners against the respondent No. 5 and 6 regarding threat were found to be false. However, as per the statement of the petitioners, college authorities have deployed & private security guards. The respondent No. 3 has also issued directions to the deponent as well as to SHO Police Station Dinanagar to ensure safety of the petitioners. The Quick Reaction Team has been deployed during college hours daily.”*

4. It is evident from perusal of the above that statements of private respondents have already been recorded and the allegation levelled by the petitioner, regarding the said respondents extending threat, were found to be false. Nonetheless, the college authorities have deployed 06 private security guards and a QRT is also being deployed during college hours.

5. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition. The same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
