1. In the present petition, the petitioner is challenging the appointment of respondent No.7, who has been appointed on the post of Salesman.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction may be given to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 04.03.2025 (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
