NIDHI GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the present contempt petition alleging violation of order dated 28.01.2009 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CR-257-2007, titled as 'M/s DSR Developers Pvt. Ltd. and others vs. Murtee Shree Ram Chander Ji Maharaj and others', whereby the said revision petition was dismissed as withdrawn with the observations that '*during the pendency of the suit the petitioners shall not change the nature of the property in dispute and will also maintain status quo with regard to the possession as well as alienation*'.

2. After arguing for some time when this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition as, the



same is not maintainable being barred by limitation. It is further admitted that the Civil Suit also stands dismissed for non-prosecution.

3. Permitted to do so.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
5. Rule stands discharged.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
