1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 483 BNSS is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.115 dated 14.11.2018, under Sections 302, 392, 34 IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act (Sections 489, 411 IPC added later on)

2. Custody certificate dated 26.04.2025 along with Status report dated 28.04.2025, in the shape of affidavit of Mandeep Kaur, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nabha, District Patiala, has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today, the same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Allegation against the petitioner is that after looting the amount of Rs.50 lakhs, present petitioner fired a shot, which resulted into causing death of victim Prem Chand. Petitioner is stated to be there inside jail for the last more than a period of 06 years.

4. Another allegation against the petitioner is that after being arrested, an amount of Rs.50 lakhs along with gun was recovered from his



possession. Petitioner is also stated to be involved in 10 other criminal cases, whereas in 09 of the cases, he has already been acquitted.

5. As far as status of trial is concerned, learned DAG Punjab, informs that out of total 46 prosecution witnesses, 28 have already been examined and 02 have been given up.

6. On being informed the status of trial and nature of allegations, this Court is not inclined to entertain the plea of grant of bail and, thus, the prayer is declined, however, direction is issued to trial Court to expedite the trial preferably within a period of 06 months from today.

7. Present petition stands disposed of.
