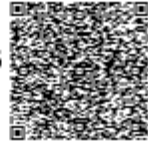

**ARCHANA PURI, J. (Oral)**

The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/474/2023, titled '*Nitin Gangerh Vs. Hanisha Rattan*', filed by the respondent-husband, pending in the Family Court, Hoshiarpur and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

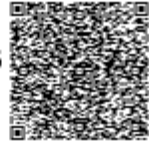
Upon notice, the respondent made appearance through counsel and filed reply.



The counsel for the parties heard.

During the course of submissions made by the respective counsel, it came forth that both the applicant, as well as the respondent, are doctors by profession. The applicant is doing post-graduation in Faridkot Medical College and the respondent is doing post-graduation in Amritsar Medical College, at present. Obviously, on account of the profession of the parties to the lis, there are bound to be pressing needs of the profession, faced by both of them and considering the place, where the divorce petition has been filed, it may become difficult for either of the parties to pursue the same, if transferred, or not so transferred. However, balancing the convenience/inconvenience of both the parties, an option has been given to both the parties to pinpoint some mid-point station between Hoshiarpur and Faridkot, where the divorce petition could be transferred, while watching the interest of both the applicant, as well as the respondent. Upon this option given, both the counsel have agreed that the divorce petition may be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

Thus, considering the submissions made by both the counsel and also watching the interest of both the applicant, as well as the respondent, more particularly, considering their professional life, the transfer application is allowed and the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/474/2023, titled '*Nitin Gangerh Vs. Hanisha Rattan*', filed by the respondent-husband, is withdrawn from the Courts at Hoshiarpur and the same stands transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. The requisite record of the aforesaid case be sent by the Family Court, Hoshiarpur, to the District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.



Learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court, Ludhiana. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court, Ludhiana, within a period of one month from today onwards.
