Present appeal under Section 14A of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short 'SC/ST Act') seeking concession of ad-interim bail for the period of four months in FIR No. 420 dated 10.10.2021, under Sections 148 read with Section 302, 323, 324 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860; Section 3 of the SC/ST Act and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonipat, District Sonipat.

(2) Status report dated 28.01.2025 by way of affidavit of Mr. Jeet Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kharkhoda, Sonipat has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1, which is taken on record. Copy supplied to the other side. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.
