1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to quash the FIR No.80 dated 22.11.2021, under Sections 21, 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Aur, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1), final report dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) and order of framing of charge dated 28.07.2022 (Annexure P-7).

2. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in the present case, the challan was presented on 24.01.2022 and the charge was ordered to be framed against the petitioners on 28.07.2022, but till date only two witnesses have been examined by the prosecution so far. Consequently,

some directions may be issued to the Trial Court to expedite the Trial.

5. I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners to be appropriate, at this stage.

6. Consequently, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably, within a period of one year from today.
