Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 06 dated 06.01.2025, under Sections 182, 195, 186, 199, 200, 211, 384 and 500 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the allegations in the FIR are primarily against the co-accused Anuraj. The petitioner has been roped in only being family member of Anuraj. It has been submitted that the petitioner after having been granted the interim bail vide order dated 19.08.2025, time and again has joined the investigation



and, thus, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant, on the other hand, has opposed the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He has submitted that the petitioner in conspiracy with Anuraj had blackmailed the complainant and extorted money from him. He further submitted that the anticipatory bail filed by co-accused Anuraj has already been declined.

Learned counsel for the State has affirmed the fact that pursuant to the order dated 19.08.2025 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands allowed.
