JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Comrade Pervesh Rani) was stated to have been elected as a Councilor with the Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, and had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 1609 of 2008*, seeking a direction of construction of Railway Over Bridge (ROB) at Jourha Fatak within the area of Municipal Corporation, Amritsar.

The Municipal Corporation and the Government, before the Division Bench, conveyed the decision in principle to build an over bridge at the said site. The aforesaid writ petition, thus, was disposed of vide order dated 19.09.2008 (**Annexure P-3**) with the observations that the finalization

of the project reports and other necessary steps would be taken in expeditious manner, so as to facilitate the execution of the project at the earliest.

Since the construction, as planned earlier, could not take place, hence for alleged violation of the observations in the order dated 19.09.2008 (P-3), present contempt was filed.

Upon notice, various status reports have been filed, wherein it is stated that due to the changed circumstances, the construction could not be taken up in time, however, RITES has now been engaged to submit a Detailed Project Report (DPR) with regard to construction and execution of the work.

In view of the above, this Court finds that no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.

Dismissed.

It is hoped that the Government, subject to its financial resources, will take steps to obviate the difficulties of the residents of the area by construction of the over bridge at the earliest.
