1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for quashing of the impugned order dated 12.11.2024 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonipat (Annexure P-4) in FIR No.232 dated 18.07.2023 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Bahalgarh, District Sonipat, whereby the bail of the petitioners has been cancelled and forfeited the bonds to the State and issued warrants of arrest of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that after the registration of the FIR No.232 dated 18.07.2023, the petitioners were granted relief of anticipatory bail vide order dated 16.10.2023 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-41347-2023 and CRM-M-40657-2023 (Annexure P-2). He submits that upon presentation of the challan, the petitioners were granted regular

bail by the Area Magistrate vide order dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-3). Thereafter, due to change of the Court room on account of transfer of the presiding officer, the petitioners remained present outside the old Court and they were marked absent on 12.11.2024 and subsequently on 04.02.2025. He further submits that the petitioners are ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aashish Bishnoi, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. In such circumstances, filing of the written response by the official respondents is dispensed with.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the petitioners have initially appeared before the trial Court and even now they are ready to face the trial, impugned order dated 12.11.2024 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonipat (Annexure P-4) is quashed subject to the condition that the petitioners shall surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today.

7. Upon the appearance of the petitioners within the stipulated period, the trial Court shall consider and decide the bail application filed by the petitioners on the same day.

8. Disposed of accordingly.

9. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
