1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to learned trial Court to decide the Discharge Report dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) submitted by police officer after investigation in FIR No.377 dated 30.10.2017, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Pundari, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mahipal, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed and the cancellation report was submitted before the learned trial Court on 31.07.2024. Now, the learned jurisdictional Court is seized of the matter and it is pending consideration for 23.05.2025 and notice has already been issued to the complainant for the said date.
