Petitioner has preferred the present revision petition under Article 227 of Constitution of India, invoking power of Superintendence vested in this Court. No order by learned Court of first instance has been challenged by way of present revision petition.

2. Learned counsel for petitioners is taking a plea that learned Court of first instance while framing issue Nos.3, 4 and 5 should have treated them as preliminary issues. Admittedly, no such prayer has been made before the Court of first instance. In absence of any prayer, no ground to interfere in the present case is made out.

3. Petition is accordingly dismissed with liberty to move appropriate application in accordance with law before the Court of first instance.
