1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482/528 of B.N.S.S read with Section 12 of Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.62, dated 22.07.2024 under Sections 118(1),126(2),351(2),3(5),118(2) {added later on} of BNS, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasmer Singh also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
