The instant petition is for quashing of Kalandra No.15 dated 06.11.2023 under Section 66 of the Punjab Police Act, 2007 (Annexure P-5), registered at Police Station, Phase 8, Mohali and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same.

2. Vide order dated 17.09.2024 the parties had been directed to appear before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement.

3. Report from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court has since been received, as per which, parties have indeed settled their dispute in terms of the settlement/agreement which is enclosed along with the report received from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.

4. Learned counsel for the parties have also reiterated before this Court that since the matter stands resolved between the parties, the prayer

made for quashing of the Kalandra in question be accepted and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom be quashed.

5. In view of the report received from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, the Kalandra in question stands quashed qua the petitioners.

6. Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.
