Present appeal was listed before the Daily Lok Adalat of this Court on 25.04.2024 where the matter has been settled between the parties and a sum of Rs.1,20,000/-, as agreed, has been ordered to be awarded to the appellant-Vikram Rana, in full & final satisfaction of the claim. Order dated 25.04.2024 reads as under:

“As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,20,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the Raj Singh S/o Amar Singh, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.1,20,000/- favouring the appellant-Raj Singh S/o Amar Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok



Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be consigned to record.”

In the wake of aforesaid, nothing substantive survives in this appeal and the same is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
