This is a Contempt Petition filed under Section 10 & 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for his willful and intentional disobedience of the order dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court

2. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that in pursuance of order dated 28.10.2024, the respondent-authority has taken decision in favour of the petitioners and has further submitted that since there are large number of petitioners to whom amount has to be released thus, the amount found due to the petitioners would be released within a period of three months from today.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the same, the present contempt petition be disposed of but respondent be bound by the statement made before this Court and liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition in case respondent does not comply with the said undertaking.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present contempt petition is disposed of at this stage. Respondent would be bound by the statement made before this Court and liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition in case respondent does not comply with the abovesaid undertaking.
