KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. The issue brought before this Court through the present writ of *quo warranto* is that the Deputy Commissioner concerned lacks the jurisdiction to decide matters relating to eviction from property. Accordingly, the petitioner asserts the right to invoke the writ of *quo warranto*.

2. Although the learned counsel for the petitioner joined the issue of maintainability of this writ petition and addressed arguments, after arguing for some time, he sought leave to withdraw this writ petition. However, he prayed for liberty to raise all the pleas, claims, and issues urged before this Court, before the authority, which is seized of the matter.

3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, this writ petition is **disposed off as withdrawn**, however, with liberty (*supra*).
