1. The office has listed this case as despite numerous requests to learned counsel for the appellant to provide current/correct address of respondent No.1, no steps have been taken so far.

2. As per office note, notice issued to the counsel, through whom the instant appeal was filed in this Court, has been received back with the report that Mr. Paramjit Batta, Advocate has returned the case file to the client.

3. Perusal of the record would show that on 07.05.2024, another counsel had put in appearance for the appellant before the Daily Lok Adalat and had sought time to implead the legal representatives of the deceased/sole appellant-Randhir Singh, who was stated to have passed away in the year 2018. No steps have been taken in that regard so far.

4. Despite the case having been called out twice, there is no representation on behalf of the appellant or the proposed legal representatives.
