By this common order I shall dispose of both the
aforementioned petitions as the same have arisen out of one and the



same FIR.

2. The prayer in these petitions under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.533 dated 16.09.2023 under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurugram.

3. The counsel for the petitioners contend that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and, therefore, they be granted the concession of bail.

4. The Counsel for the State admits the fact that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. However, looking at the nature of the allegations, the petitioners are not entitled to the concession of bail.

4. The Counsel for the complainant admits the a compromise has been arrived at between the petitioners on the one hand and the complainant on the other hand and states that he has no objection if the petitioners are granted the concession of bail.

5. I have heard counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the fact that compromise has been arrived at between the parties, report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC already stands presented and petitioners have undergone substantial period of imprisonment, their further incarceration is not required.

7. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petitions are allowed and the petitioners-**Kavindra** son of Sh. Dheeraj Bhatti, **Naresh Sharma @ Narender Kumar @ Munna** son
