This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 18.12.2018 passed in CWP No. 27604 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Keeping in view the request made by counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation Annexure P-7 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any relief, the same shall also be released to them within a period of next three months."

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Manoj Yadava, Director General of Police, Haryana, has been filed and same is taken on record.

Along with reply an order dated 3.6.2019 has been annexed whereby the claim of the petitioners has been rejected and copy supplied to opposite counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter-alia* submits that the claim has wrongly been rejected, as similar claim were accepted by other department. He seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 3.6.2019.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
