This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0090 dated 18.09.2024 registered under Sections 309(4), 191(3), 190 of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Offences Under Sections 111(2), 111(3), 111(5) and 61(2) BNS 2023 added later on) at Police Station Kathu Nangal District Amritsar Rural.

Today, affidavit dated 11.07.2025 of the petitioner has been filed by his counsel whereby the petitioner has tendered unconditional apology asserting that his absence before this Court

despite issuance of directions was due to ignorance and misunderstanding as well as miscommunication and on that account he was arrested, the same is taken on record.

Considering the fact that petitioner stands arrested and has tendered unconditional apologies, the same is accepted. The show cause notice dated 24.01.2025 stands discharged against him.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
