The revision petition has been filed seeking a direction to the Executing Court/District Judge, Panchkula, to decide the petitioner/decreed holder's execution application dated 29.11.2023, Annexure P-6, expeditiously in a time bound manner.

2. Pursuant to order dated 27.02.2025 passed by this Court, status report dated 10.06.2025 has been received from Additional District & Sessions Judge, Panchkula, perusal whereof shows that the matter has been adjourned time and again on account of various reasons. Arguments on the execution application could not be heard, though reply/objections have been filed. It remains undisputed that there is no stay on deciding the application.

3. In the light of facts aforementioned, it is established that the execution application filed by the petitioner on 29.11.2023, has not been decided despite lapse of more than one and a half year. This is in violation of



directions issued by the Supreme Court in SLP (C) Nos. 8490-8492 of 2020 titled *Periyammal (Dead) through LRs and others v. Rajamani and another*. Based upon which instructions, dated 03.04.2025, have been issued by the Registrar General of this Court to all the District and Sessions Judges to dispose of the pending execution petitions within six months starting from 01.04.2025 without fail, and not to give unnecessary or long adjournments.

4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of directing the executing Court/ District Judge, Panchkula, to expeditiously decide the pending execution application, preferably within six weeks of receiving a certified copy of the order.
