1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 11.11.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by Sessions Judge, Barnala, vide which learned Court has dismissed an application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. moved by the petitioner seeking permission to lead additional evidence in criminal complaint.

2. Petitioner is seeking examination of two official witnesses who have recorded video footage and taken photographs at the time of removing the dead body of the deceased in order to corroborate his version that the case in hand is not a suicide, however, it is a murder.

3. Learned State counsel and learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the contention of the petitioner made hereinabove.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.



5. After examining the record as well as the order in hand, this Court finds no infirmity with the order of the Court below dated 11.11.2020 since the case of the prosecution stands duly proved through post mortem as well as inquest report. It is a case of the state that they have not relied on any such photographs and any videography which was conducted there is enough evidence on record by way of post mortem and inquest report.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as such.
