The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and release the entire amount of medical bills, i.e., ₹5,34,395.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 13.12.2024, Annexure P-8, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 13.12.2024, will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
