Petition herein is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to implement their own orders dated 25.08.2020 (Annexure P3) and 17.06.2022 (Annexure P4).

2. The nature the prayer infers that the Annexure P4 be complied with by implementing it by the authority concerned. Annexure P4 is issued by respondent No.2 and further, to be implemented by respondent No.1.

3. In respect to the aforesaid grievance, a representation/ legal notice has already been made by the petitioners as Annexure P6 before respondent No.1, which is pending for implementation.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the said representation/ legal notice (Annexure P-6) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.
