**RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 03.07.2025 under Sections 331(4), 305 and 3(5) BNS, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

2. On 05.09.2025, following order had been passed: -

*“ Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 03.07.2025 registered under Sections 331(4), 305 and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.*

*Brief facts as per the prosecution case are that the petitioner along with co-accused had stolen the wire of electric motor installed in the fields of the complainant in the intervening night of 01/02.07.2025.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further contends that neither the petitioner was present at the spot nor was named in the FIR. He argued that when the alleged occurrence had taken place, the petitioner was not there and rather, he along with his family members had gone to meet his sister at Mohalla Mohini Parka, near Khalsa College, Amritsar. It has also been contended that the present petitioner has been nominated in this case as an accused only on the basis of suspicion*



*without any concrete evidence, that too only upon the supplementary statement of the complainant-Jasjeet Singh made on 05.07.2025. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the investigating agency.*

*Notice of motion.*

*On asking of the Court, Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and seeks time to file status report in the matter.*

*Adjourned to 01.10.2025.*

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within a week from today and would appear as and when required by the Investigating Officer and cooperate with the Investigating Agency. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.09.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 05.09.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
