1. Learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the Central Administrative Tribunal (hereinafter referred as “the CAT”) has reserved the case on 17.01.2025 and pronounced it on 17.02.2025 with the presumptions that the Transfer Scheme had not been finalized as per the provisions of Sections 133 and 134 of the Electricity Act, 2003 whereas factually, it was an error as the Scheme had already been finalized and notified on 31.01.2025 and the respondents had acted upon the said Scheme. It is his submission that the Transfer Scheme, as notified, needs to be examined by the CAT.

2. Considering the position as above, we allow the petitioners to withdraw the present Writ Petition with liberty file a review application



before the CAT with an appropriate application referring to the challenge to the Transfer Scheme, if they so choose.

3. If an application is filed by the petitioners within a period of one month from today, it is expected from the CAT to examine the aspects on merits and decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

4. Accordingly, the Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

5. All pending applications in this case are disposed of accordingly.
