This application has been filed by the applicants-appellants seeking revival of the case as the same was consigned to record room, due to non-appearance of the appellant despite service, vide order dated 19.12.2024 passed by this Forum with a liberty to the appellant to revive the same by filing an appropriate application.

Notice of the application was issued on 14.02.2025 and Mr. Abhimanyu Batra, Advocate had accepted the notice on behalf of the Insurance Company

In view the facts and circumstances stated in the application, the same is allowed and the appeal is taken up for disposal.

FAO-485-2019

As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant-Hariya.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in the name of appellant-Hariya with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.04.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
