AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant(s) as well as counsel for both the Insurance Companies-each company is having 50% liability, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lacs only) to the appellant(s) in both the appeals, over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant(s) in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount be released in favour of the appellant(s) in both the appeals as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Companies to deposit cheque of Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lacs only) in favour of the appellant(s) in both the appeals as per MACT award with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.10.2025. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per
